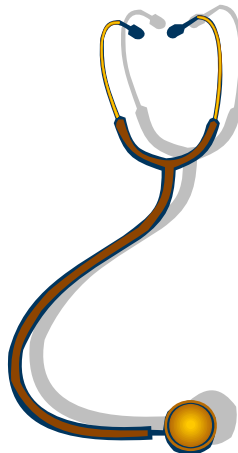
PRE-SOMA
